State of Utah High School Requirements

- 4 Credits of Language Arts (LA 9, LA 10, LA11, LA12)
- 3 Credits of Math (SM 1, SM 2, SM 3, **or** Math for Life)
- 3 Credits of Science (Earth Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, AP Computer Science, and Medical Anatomy & Physiology)
- 3 Credits of Social Science (Geography, World Civ, US History, US Gov, + 0.5 SS elective (Economics, Psychology))
- 1.5 Credits of Fine Art (Drawing I, Drawing II, Basic Digital Photography)
- 2.0 Credits of Physical Education (Physical Skills, Fitness For Life, Health, + 0.5 PE elective (Individual Lifetime Activities))
- 0.5 Credit of Digital Studies (Business Office Specialist, Digital Business Applications, or Python)
- 0.5 Credit of Financial Literacy
- At least 6.5 Credits of CTE (the State of Utah only requires 1.0 credits, but CTHS has specific pathway requirements)
- At least 3.0 Credits of electives

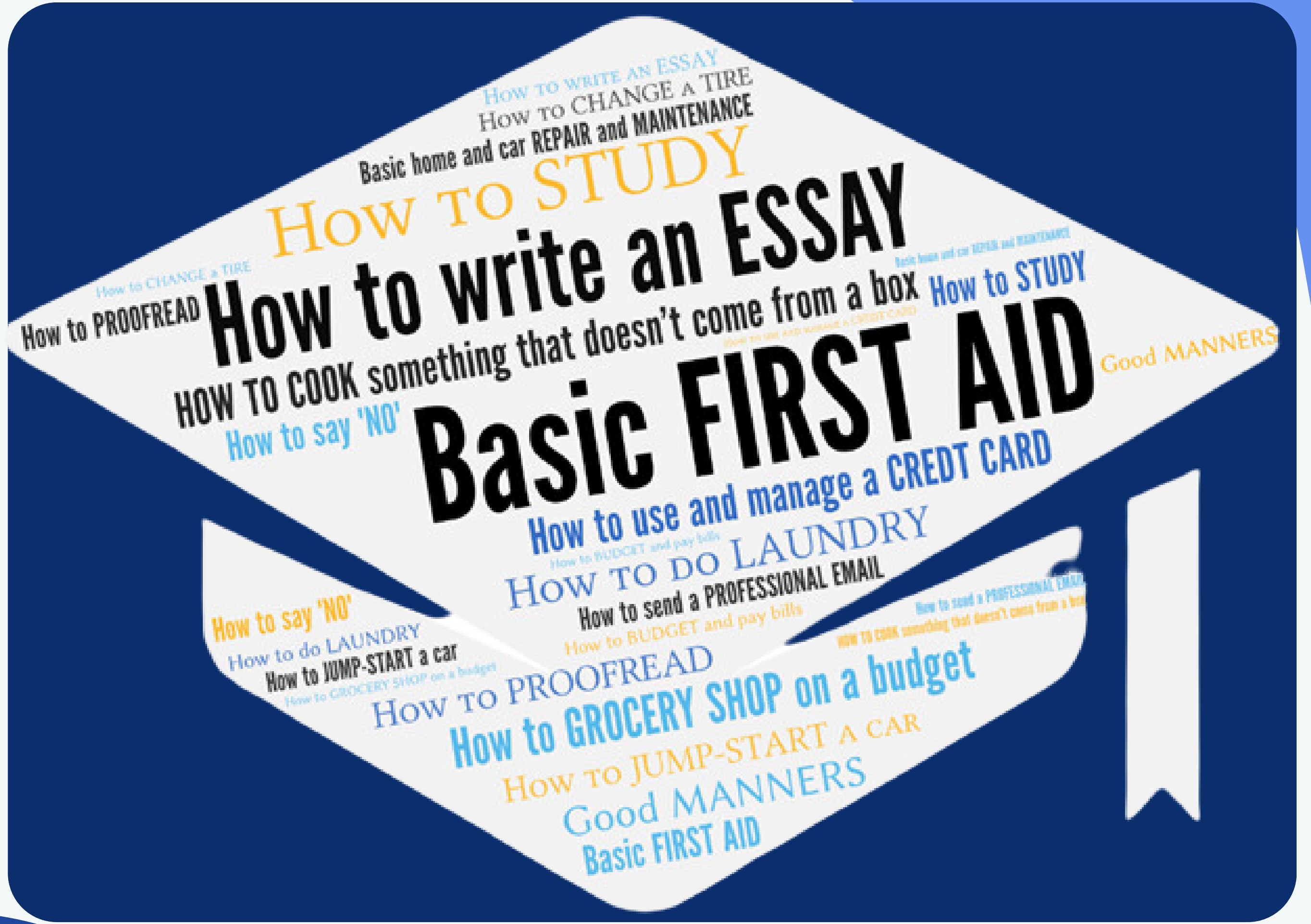

Utah Colleges and Universities

- **Research Universities** – The University of Utah (UofU) is Utah's flagship research university. Utah State University (USU) also performs extensive research as the state's land-grant university.
- **Regional Universities** – Institutions such as Weber State University (WSU), Utah Tech University (UT), and Utah Valley University (UVU) perform both a community college and a four-year college function primarily in the region they are located. Some schools even offer master's degrees. Southern Utah University (SUU) is Utah's designated liberal arts and sciences university and offers certificates, and bachelor's and master's degrees.
- **Community Colleges** – Primarily two-year public institutions that grant certificates, diplomas, and associate's degrees. Utah has Salt Lake Community College, Snow College, and USU Eastern as well as four-year institutions that provide community college services across the state.

Financing Higher Education

Financial aid is generally available in one of the following types:

Grants—federal/state money given to those who qualify based on financial need

Scholarships—money given for education, no need for repayment

Work-study—money given to a qualified individual in exchange for work

Loans—money loaned at a favorable rate but must be repaid

FAFSA - Free Application for Federal Student Aid, a part of the U.S. Department of Education, is the largest provider of student financial aid in the nation. By filling out the application online you can qualify for more than \$150 billion in federal grants, loans, and work-study funds to help pay for college or career school.

Financing Higher Education

Scholarship Index Utah Resident (First-Year)

- Only one score (GPA or ACT or SAT) is required for all scholarships except President's
- Best score is used for scholarships requiring only one score
- Minimum 2.3 GPA required for scholarships awarded based upon ACT or SAT
- GPA scale is unweighted (4.00 is highest)

ACT and SAT scores DO NOT include the Writing sections of the exams.
